REQUEST FOR EXCEPTIONS OF BRANCH AFFILIATION

NATIONAL CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS ARTICLE III SECTION 6 Subsection (a)

The Executive Board shall accept requests from members for affiliation with another branch when the member was affected by Postal Service initiated consolidations. The Area Vice President shall investigate said petition by contact with the involved member and branches and report said findings to the Executive Board for concurrence.

A member who wishes to apply and receive an exception should forward the following information to their Area Vice President. If the member meets the criteria as established by the Constitution and Bylaws the Area Vice President will complete the form and forward it to NAPS Headquarters where the exception will be created for the next month's DCO. Any request which is denied will be returned to the member indicating the reason. Following the granting of said exception, any change in the members permanent finance number will negate the exception and the member will need to reapply.
